

#### MPSA/EP: Distribution per Province









■APPLIED EP & MPSA ■TOTAL LAND AREA




#### TOTAL CARAGA LAND AREA VS TOTAL APPROVED MINING AREAS







RA 7942 Provides the following mitigating measures that would ensure that the mining operation in the country be in the government standard:




#### STAGES OF MINING: Nickel


