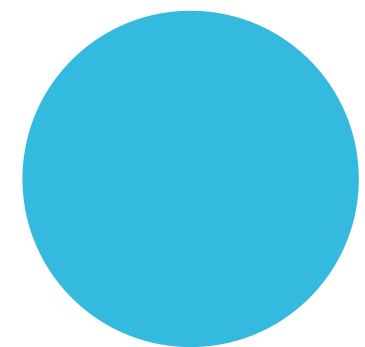
FOR JOURNALISTIC PURPOSES

We consider data to be any computerized file that uses columns and rows to organize data that are represented as text, numbers, dates and the like.

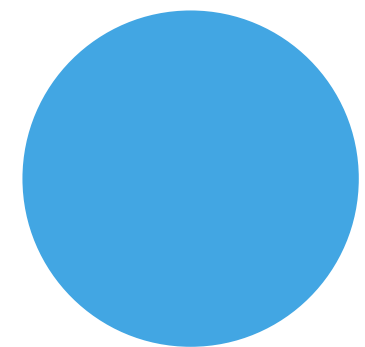
SUMMARIZED OR AGGREGATED DATA

May 9, 2022 National and Local Elections

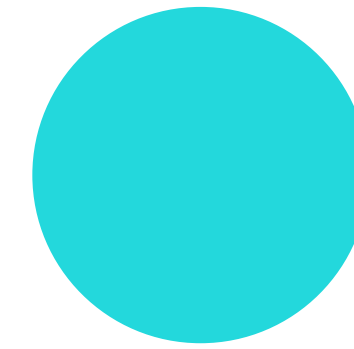

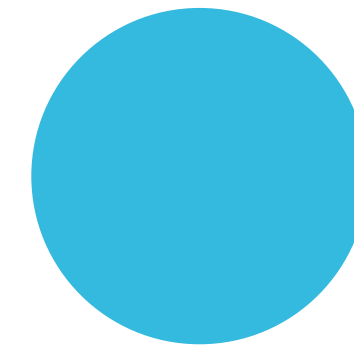

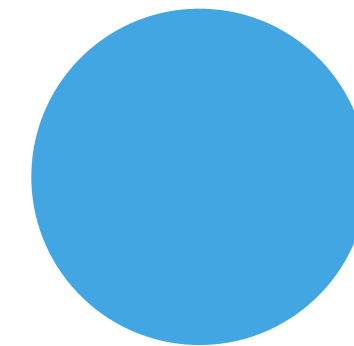
DISAGGREGATED OR RAW DATA

No calculations yet, or generated a report from the data. Release of raw data is usually part of open-government initiatives.

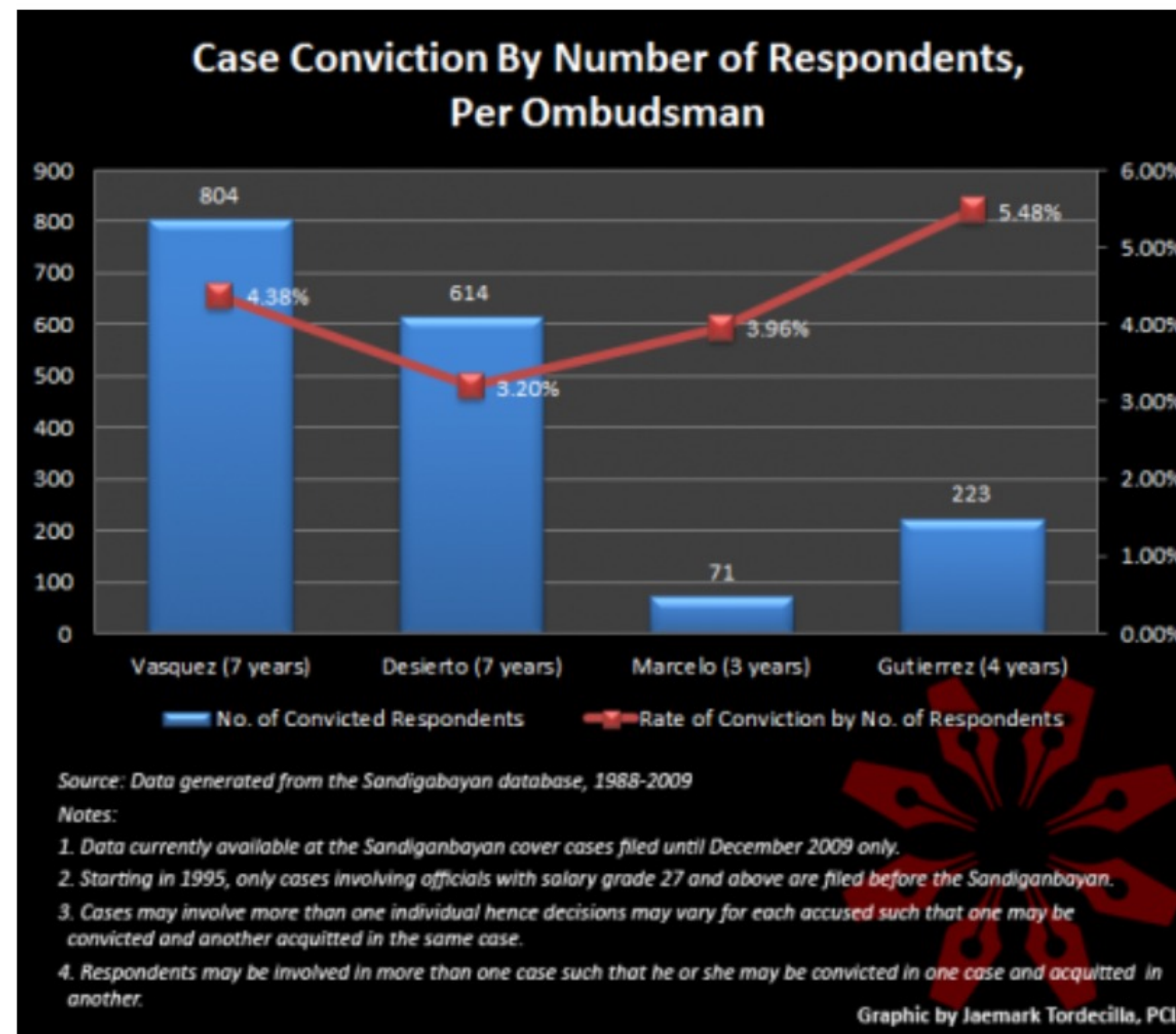

Good, bad results

Under Gutierrez, the Ombudsman has filed at least 1,210 cases with the Sandiganbayan. In addition, it inherited a backlog of 1,916 cases that were left pending from the time of Marcelo, Desierto, and even Vasquez.

This backlog included the plunder case against former President Joseph Estrada that was filed in April 2001 under Desierto. Estrada was convicted of plunder in September 2007, on Year 2 of Gutierrez's term, but was eventually pardoned by then President Gloria Macapagal Arroyo, who inherited power from Estrada after his impeachment trial at the Senate triggered a second people-power revolt.



The conviction rate of cases by the office of Merceditas Gutierrez is an illusory picture of good results. A closer review of the 223 cases she steered to conviction shows that almost all – 221 cases to be exact – were filed against just one official, the mayor of Nakar, Quezon province. The two other cases involved a municipal mayor of Iloilo, and a city mayor of Nueva Ecija.

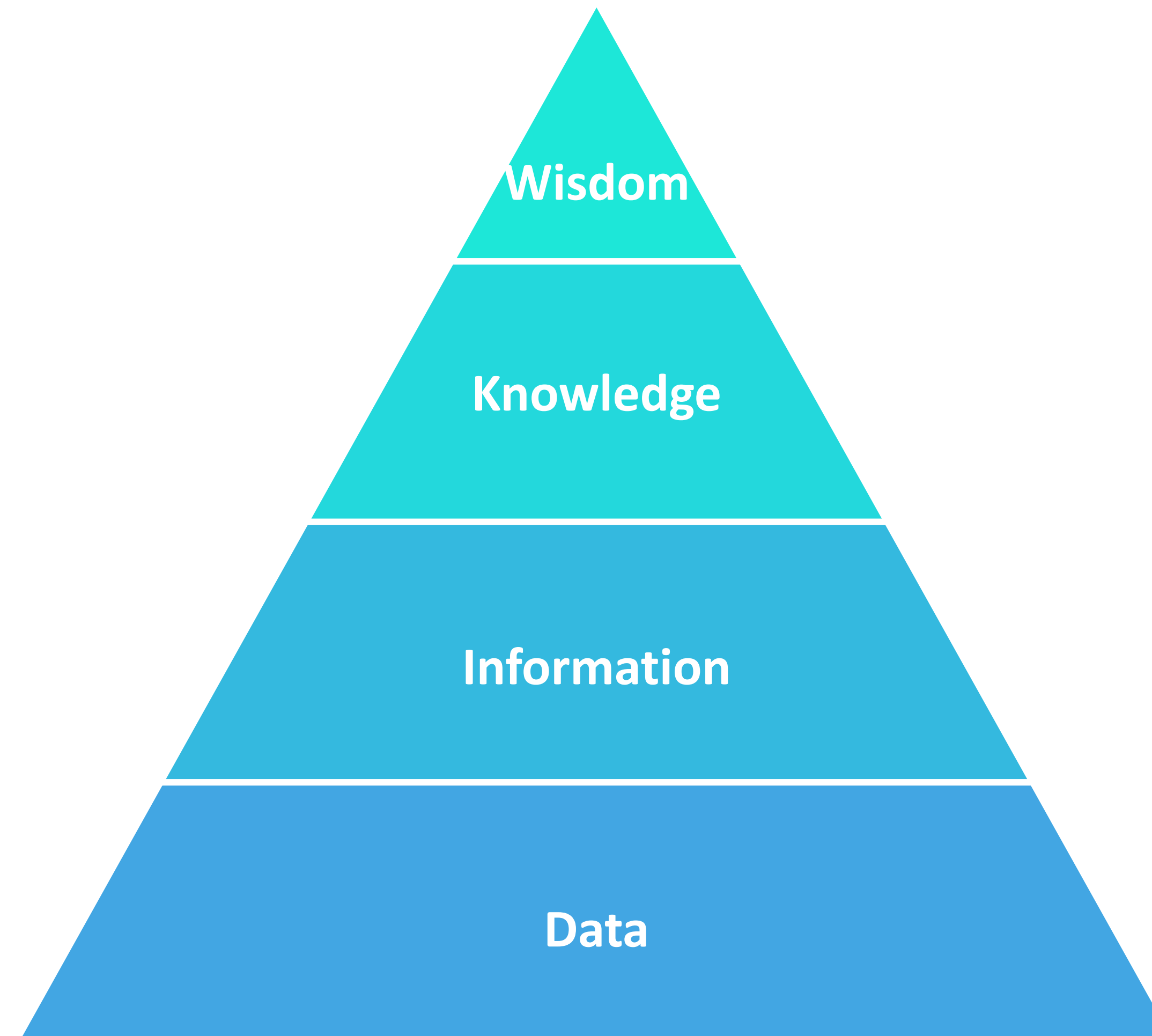

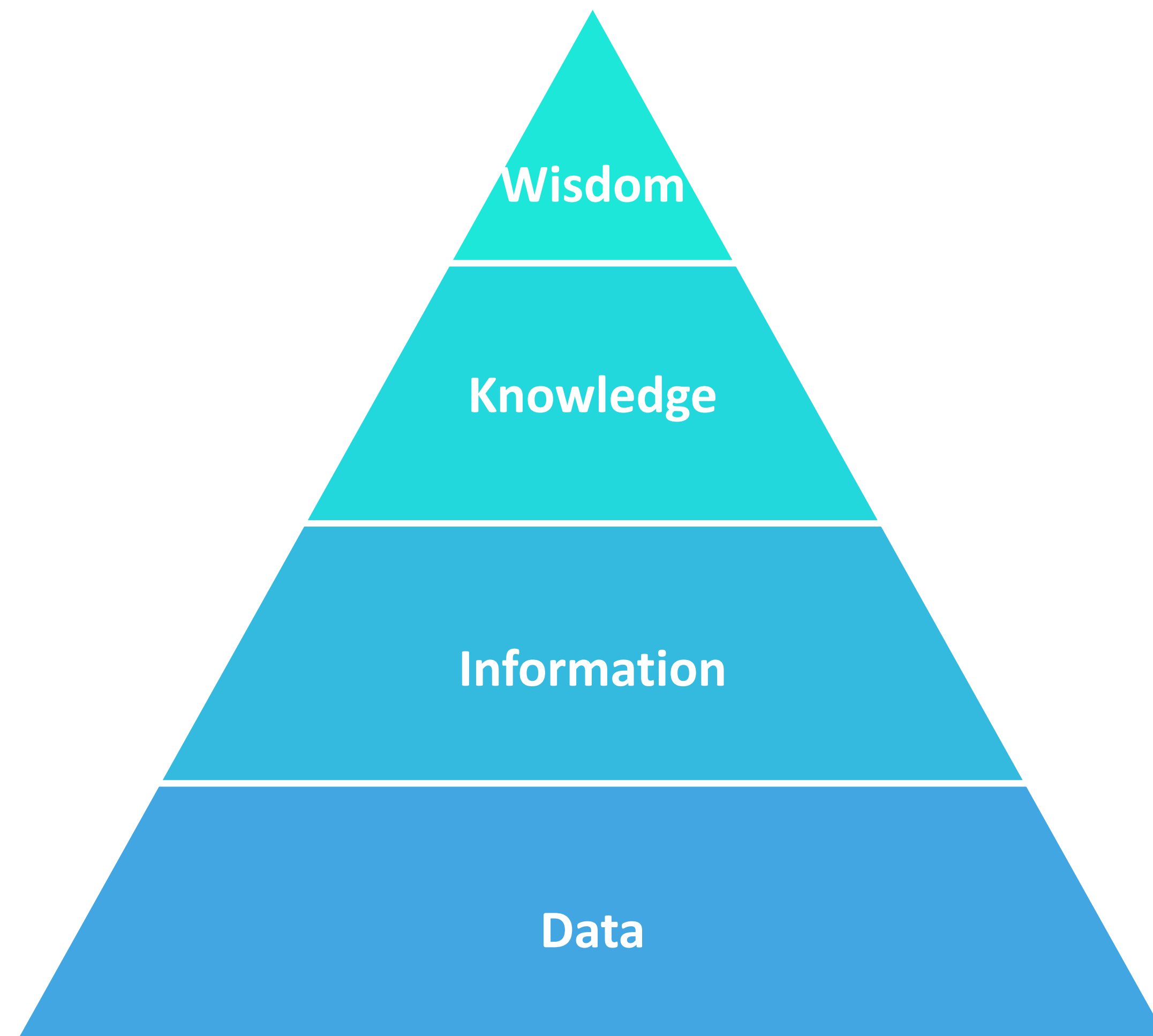

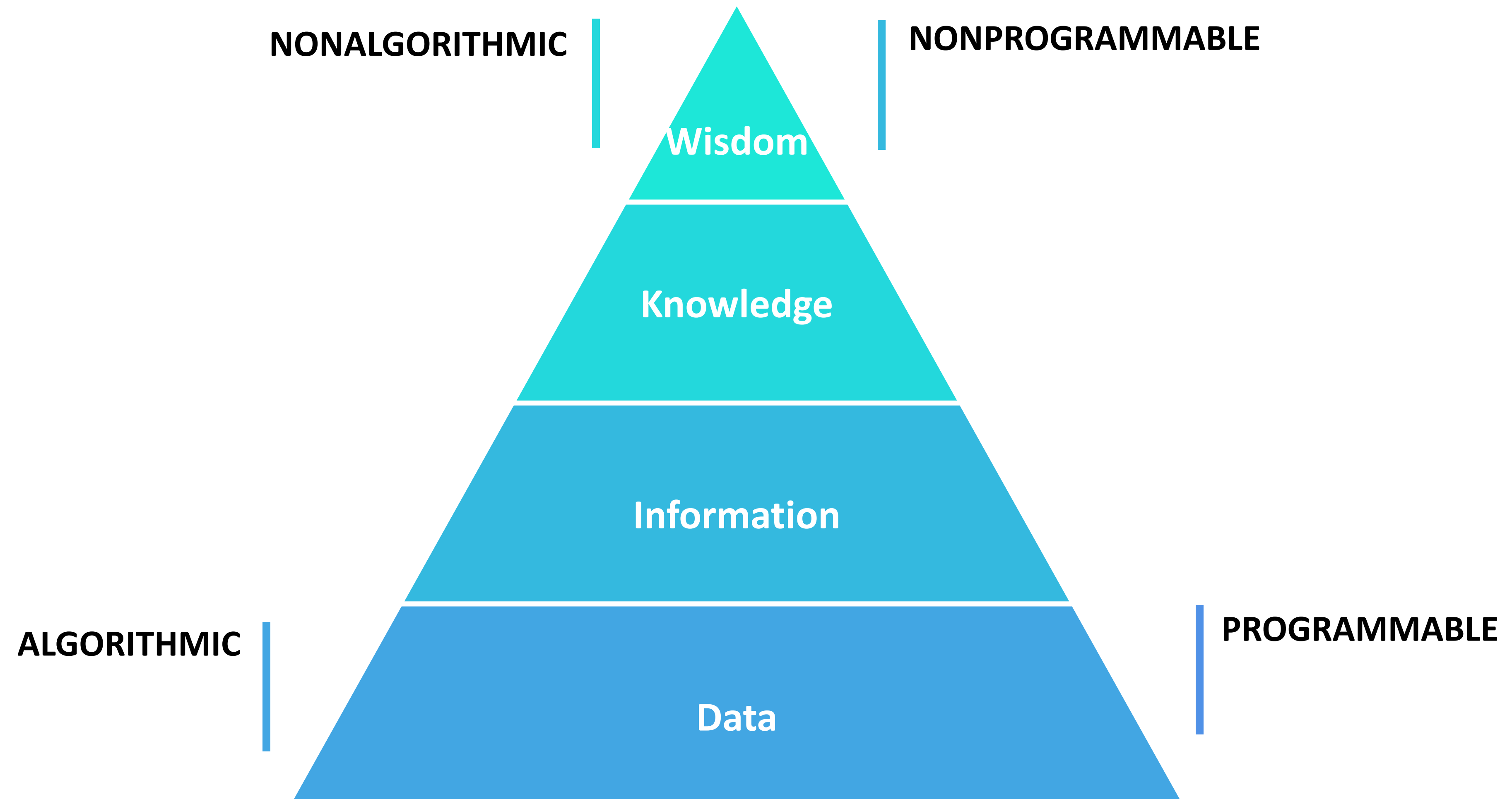

**AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE MODERNIZATION, STANDARIZATION AND REGULATION OF THE
PROCUREMENT ACTIVITIES OF THE GOVERNMENT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

**ARTICLE 1
GENERAL PROVISIONS**

Section 1. Short Title.- This act shall be known as the " Government Procurement reform Act."

Section 2. Declaration of Policy.- It is the declared policy of the State to promote the ideals of good governance in all its branches, departments, agencies, subdivisions, and instrumentalities, including government-owned and/or -controlled corporations and local government units.

Section 3. Governing Principles on Government Procurement.

All procurement of the national government, its departments, bureaus, offices and agencies, including state universities and colleges, government -owned and/or-controlled corporations, government financial institutions and local government units, shall, in all cases, be governed by these principles:

(a) Transparency in the procurement process and in the implementation of procurement contracts.

(b) Competitiveness by extending equal opportunity to enable private contracting parties who are eligible and qualified to participate in public bidding.

(c) Streamlined procurement process that will uniformly apply to all government procurement. The procurement process shall simple and made adaptable to advances in modern technology in order to ensure an effective and efficient method.

(d) System of accountability where both the public officials directly or indirectly involved in the procurement process as well as in the implementation of procurement contracts and the private parties that deal with government are, when warranted by circumstances, investigated and held liable for their actions relative thereto.

ARTICLE III

PROCUREMENT BY ELECTRONIC MEANS

Section 8. *Procurement By Electronic Means.*- To promote transparency and efficiency, information and communications technology shall be utilized in the conduct of procurement procedures. Accordingly, there shall be single portal that shall serve as the primary source of information on all government procurement. The G-EPS shall serve as the primary and definitive source of information on government procurement. Further, the GPPB is authorized to approve changes in the procurement process to adapt to improvements in modern technology, provided that such modifications are consistent with provisions of Section 3 of this Act.

To take advantage of the significant built-in-efficiencies of the G-EPS and the volume discounts inherent in bulk purchasing, all Procuring Entities shall utilize the G-EPS for the procurement of common supplies in accordance with the rules and procedures to be established by the GPPB. With regard to the procurement of non-common use items, infrastructure projects and consulting services, agencies may hire service providers to undertake their electronic procurement provided these service providers meet the minimum requirements set by the GPPB.

Section 9. *Security, Integrity and Confidentiality.*- The G-EPS shall ensure the security, integrity and confidentiality of documents submitted through the system. It shall include feature that provides for an audit trail for on-line transactions and allow the Commission on Audit to verify the security and integrity of the systems at any time.

2) **Renewal of contract for regular and recurring services.**¹⁵² The end-user shall state in the contract/PO the renewal of contract for regular and recurring services and the required performance evaluation of the service provider.⁽ⁿ⁾

3) **Posting of Notice of Award, Contract and Notice to Proceed.**¹⁵³ Unless the contract involves and affects national security as determined by the HOPE in accordance with Section IV(D) of this Guidelines, the BAC, through its Secretariat, shall **post** the NOA, Contract/PO, including the NTP if necessary, for information purposes, in the PhilGEPS website, the website of the Procuring Entity concerned, if available, and at any conspicuous place reserved for this purpose in the premises of the Procuring Entity within ten (10) days from their issuance, except for contracts with ABC of Fifty Thousand Pesos (₱50,000.00) and below.

M. Bid, Performance and Warranty Securities.¹⁵⁴

Bid security may be dispensed with. However, performance and/or warranty securities are required for the following alternative methods of procurement, in accordance with Sections 39 and 62 of the IRR as summarized below:

7 in 10 ODA projects fail to deliver touted benefits

This three-part series written by Roel R. Landingin, Manila senior correspondent of The Financial Times of London, caps a six-month review by the PCIJ of project and official documents covering 71 ODA projects funded by the Philippines biggest ODA lenders.

Part 3 reveals that seven in 10 projects reviewed have failed to deliver the promised economic benefits, and now posit to exacerbate the nation's debt burden.

AT LEAST seven in 10 projects funded by Official Development Assistance (ODA) loans have failed to deliver their touted benefits and results, according to a six-month study of project documents conducted by the Philippine Center for Investigative Journalism (PCIJ).

Stories about “white elephants” — grand but unfinished or unused public works projects, such as the Bataan Nuclear Power Plant in the '80s to the Telepono sa Barangay program in recent years abound. Yet many more ODA-funded projects disappoint, even after completion and roll-out.

Project completion and post-evaluation reports on scores of projects bankrolled by the Philippines' top three lenders show that 73 percent of completed foreign-assisted projects fell below estimates of economic benefits made during appraisal stage.

The reports covered 71 projects and sub-projects funded by the Japan Bank for International Cooperation (JBIC), Asian Development Bank (ADB), and World Bank.

The economic returns were about the same or slightly better than forecast in only 27 percent of the projects, the reports showed.

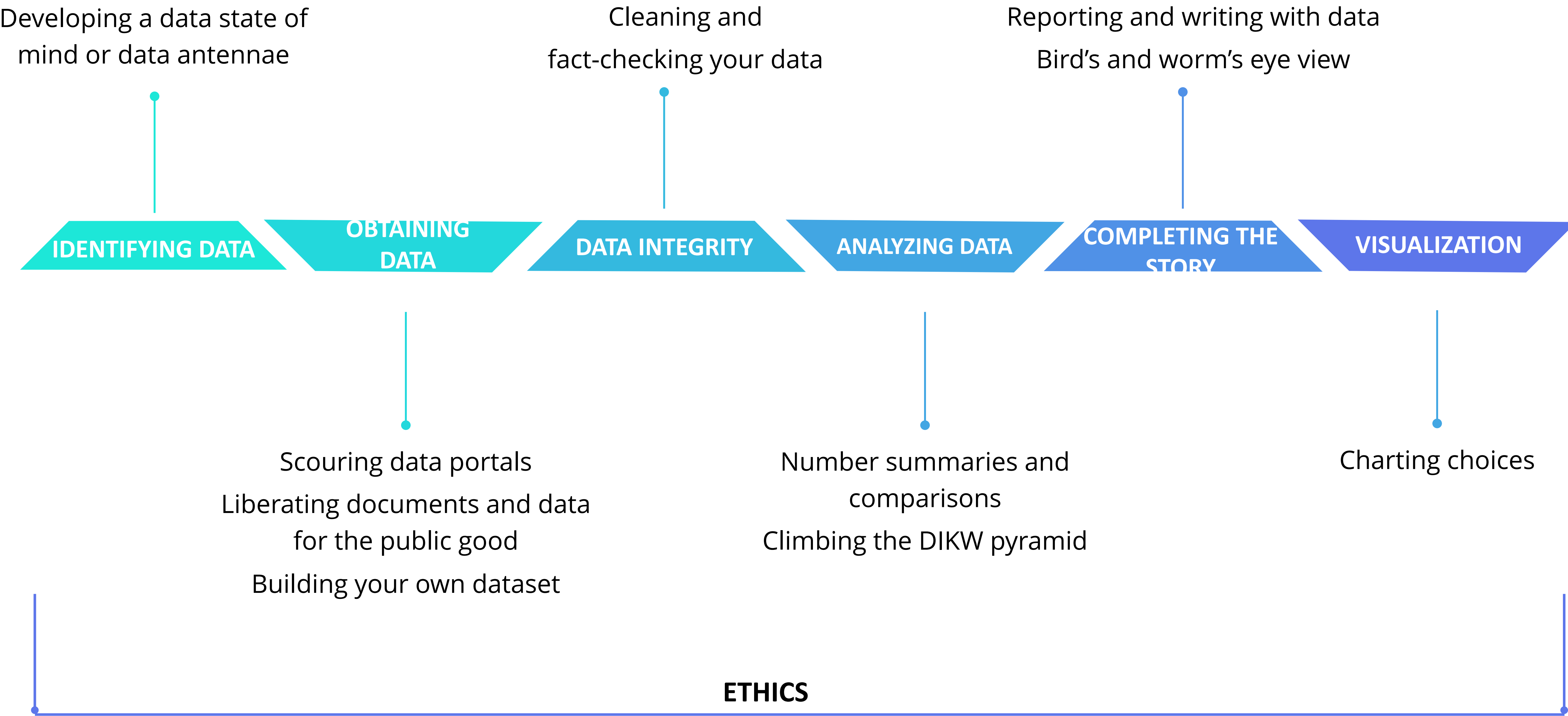
